2 05-03-2018 *Inter alia* contending that the students, who are natives of Bihar, but have passed MBBS examination from the Medical Colleges situated outside Bihar and recognized by the Medical Council of India are not being granted admission in Post Graduate Medical Courses under State quota, this writ petition has been filed in a public interest.

Taking note of the grievance of the petitioner, we are not inclined to interfere into such an issue in a public interest writ petition. It is for the person aggrieved and who has been denied admission to the Post Graduate Medical Course to ventilate his grievance in accordance with law by filing a writ petition if



aggrieved.

With the aforesaid liberty to an aggrieved person, we dispose of the matter.
