the petitioner and learned AC to GA-1 for the respondent-State.

The present writ application has been filed for quashing the order dated 31.10.2017, passed by Respondent No.3, the Assistant Inspector General of Registration, Patna in Stamp Case No. 202 of 2017, whereby the petitioner has been directed to deposit the deficit stamp, penalty as well as the interest on delayed submission of deficit stamp.

After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ application to file appeal before appropriate forum.



Permission is accorded.

Accordingly, the present writ application is dismissed as withdraw with above mentioned liberty to the petitioner.
