ORAL ORDER

3 07-03-2018 A preliminary objection is raised to say that as this Court is exercising its limited jurisdiction under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'), this application under Section 29A (4) & (5) of the Act is not maintainable before this Court.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this application that has been filed under Section 29A (4) & (5) of the Act with



liberty to file an application either before the appropriate Court empowered under law and having jurisdiction to exercise in the matter under Section 29A (4) (5) of the Act or to take such proceedings as may be permissible in law with regard to the grievance in question.

The application is permitted to be withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
