2 25-01-2018 The grievance of the petitioner is regarding

non- grant of the benefits of A.C.P./ M.A.C.P. already sanctioned
to him as well as consequential benefits and its arrears which
should have been paid to him.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

he would be filing a fresh representation before the respondent
no. 2 within two weeks from today which may be directed to be
disposed of within a specified time.



It is directed that if the petitioner files a representation within two weeks from today before the respondent no. 2, the same shall be disposed of by the respondent no. 2 by a speaking and reasoned order within four weeks thereafter and in case, any dues are found to be outstanding, the same shall be paid to the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
