2 27-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 4 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 4 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in



case such representation is filed before the respondent no. 4, then the same may be considered and disposed of within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order considering the fact that the District Compassionate Committee has the power to relax the age for appointment, as has been held by this Court in a judgment dated 28.11.2017 passed in CWJC No. 6332 of 2017.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
