counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks payment of differential amount of PF amounting to Rs. 169863/- with admissible interest. He submits that under the Provident Fund amount, he has received only Rs. 226262/- whereas he ought to have received Rs. 396125/- and hence claims for differential amount of Rs. 169863/- with up-to- date interest.

Considering the nature of claim made by the petitioner, this writ application is disposed of with a direction to the Respondent No.4, the District Provident Fund Officer, Muzaffarpur to look into the claim of the petitioner and make



payment of the admissible Provident Fund amount with
statutory interest within a period of four months from the
receipt/production of the copy of this order.
