2 15-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offence
under Section -30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution case, in short, is that 17.5 litres wine is
recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner is in custody since 29-09-2017 and has got no criminal
antecedent. Charge-sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in this
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses against the
petitioners. It is alleged that 17.5 litres wine is recovered from a bag
kept at the carrier of bicycle, in question. There is no compliance of
Section-100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that petitioner is



named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Udakishunganj, Madhepura in connection with Chausa P.S. Case No. 270 of 2017.
