Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for bail by the learned I/c 4th Addl. District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Bhagalpur, in connection with Jagdishpur Police Station Case No.141 of 2015 registered under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(ii)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Co-accused Bino Yadav @ Bindo Yadav having similar allegation has already been allowed bail by this Court vide Annexure-2. Only material against the appellant is suspicion of commission of murder of the husband of the informant.



Hence, let the appellant, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with condition that the appellant shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

Accordingly, the appeal stands allowed.
