4 11-04-2018 Supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the
petitioner is kept on record.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Though the FIR of robbery is against unknown.
A motorcycle was recovered from possession of the petitioner said
to be a stolen property. Through supplementary affidavit, the
petitioner has produced paper of the recovered motorcycle.

Submission is that the petitioner was never put on
TI Parade. Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Panjawara Police Station Case No. 107 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
