Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case she is granted liberty to file a fresh representation before the respondent no. 2 and the respondent no. 2 may be directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a specified time frame.
