3 04-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

Petitioners, already in custody, seek bail in connection with Katoria P.S. Case No.189 of 2017, registered under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation in brief is that within six months of the marriage, the daughter of the informant was killed by the family members of in-laws for not fulfilling the demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegations are false and petitioners, father-in-law and mother-in-law live separately; whereas the learned counsel for the State submits that it is a case of homicide as post-mortem report reveals that the deceased was strangled.



Having considered the said facts and circumstances,
the prayer of bail of the petitioners is present rejected in
connection with Katoria P.S. Case No.189 of 2017, pending in
the court of learned ACJM-I, Banka.
