2 30-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 2 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified



time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed before the respondent no. 2, then the same may be considered and disposed of within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order.

It is needless to state that in case any amount is found payable, the same shall be paid within a period of six weeks from the date of passing of the final order.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
