Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

the petitioner is a driver and he is in custody since 11.08.2016 and

uptill now only one witness has been examined in this case.

Heard learned A.P.P as well as learned counsel for the

Central Government.

Having heard both sides and in view of the recovery of

huge quantity of Ganja, I am not inclined to grant bail to the



petitioner.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude it within a reasonable time. Learned counsel for the Central Government is also directed to conclude the trial within a reasonable time.

With the above observation, this application is dismissed
