State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Chandi P.S. Case No. 78 of 2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 30 (a), 30 (d) of Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act.

The police on secret information raided the farm of
the petitioner and found accused persons making illicit liquor and
from their possession 45 litres of semi-prepared wine were
recovered.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of
the petitioner. The alleged recovery has been made from a field
nor the poultry farm with which petitioner has no concern.



Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge, VI, cum Special Judge, Excise, Nalanda in connection with Chandi P.S. Case No. 78 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
