ORAL ORDER

2 19-06-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection with Paroo P.S.Case No. 14 of 2018 registered under Sections 399,402,412 and 414 of the Indian penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Allegation in brief is that police raided the place of occurrence on receiving information regarding assembly of some miscreants and apprehended them including the petitioner and recovered loaded country made pistol from his possession.

Submission is that alleged recovery is false and prior to institution of the present, he had no criminal antecedent and subsequently has been made accused in another case and is in custody since 10.01.2018 and similarly situated co-accused Mantu Sahni and Ramayan Sahni have been admitted to bail by co-ordinate Benches of this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 27025 of



2018 and Cr. Misc. No. 28418 of 2018 respectively.

Having considered the period of custody and the case of the petitioner standing on similar footing to other co-accused who have been admitted to bail by co-ordinate Benches of this Court, the petitioner, namely, Mukesh Ram @ Doctor, is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM 3rd, (West) Muzaffarpur in connection with Paroo P.S. Case No. 14 of 2018.
