3 26-07-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 13.02.2018 in
connection with Gaya Mufassil P.S. Case No.56 of 2018
registered for the offence under Sections 401, 411 of the Indian
Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there
was no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner,
though the recovery of arms and ammunition was from the
conscious possession of Umesh Yadav and Lokesh Kumar Das.
It is on the basis of the confession of these two persons that the
petitioner has been implicated in connection with the present
case. It is further submitted that so far as the petitioner is



concerned, neither he was arrested at the place of occurrence nor any stolen article was recovered from his possession.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Gaya Mufassil P.S. Case No.56 of 2018.
