2 10-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Section 354A, 354B of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the petitioner
committed indecent act with the minor daughter of informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no
allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is neighbour of the informant. There is
land dispute between them. For the said reason, the present case
has been instituted. No specific overt act has been alleged
against the petitioner. There is a case and counter case between
the parties.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Muzaffarpur in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 39 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
