ORAL ORDER

2 14-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. C-153 of 2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 417 of the Indian Penal Code.

The contents of complaint petition go to show that it was petitioner no. 1 who played entire game and it was he, who took the complainant to Delhi and gave him forged Passport and Visa. So far as petitioners no. 2, 3 and 4 are concerned, they appear to be family members of petitioner no. 1 and no serious allegation has been levelled against them.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, it is ordered that petitioner no. 2, namely, Naveen Kumar, petitioner no. 3, namely, Jatadhari Lal Singh @ Jatadhari Lal and petitioner no. 4, namely, Lal Bahadur Singh, in the event of their arrest/ surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the court concerned, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Raxaul at Motihari in Complaint Case No. C-153 of 2016, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

So far as petitioner no. 1, namely, Nitesh Kumar is concerned, his prayer for anticipatory bail stands rejected.
