2     19-02-2018             The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his claim regarding his grievances is considered and his representation is disposed off in a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that in case the petitioner files a representation regarding his grievances before the respondent no. 2 within a period of two weeks from today, the respondent no. 2 shall dispose off the same by a speaking and reasoned order within a period of three weeks thereafter.

It goes without saying that in case the authorities find that the claim of the petitioner is admissible, the consequential



benefits would be paid within a period of four weeks from  
passing of the final order.

The writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
