Petitioner seeks bail in **Mojahidpur (Babarganj) P.S.**

Case No.45 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s)
457, 380, 411 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the First Information Report. No Test Identification Parade has been held. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from his possession. Name of the petitioner has been disclosed by co-accused, Raja Mallik, in his confessional statement during investigation.

Petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, XI, Bhgalpur**, in connection with **Mojahidpur (Babarganj) P.S. Case No.45 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
