learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection  
with Laxmipur (Gidhaur) P. S. Case No.124 of 2017 registered  
under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 307, 427, 504 & 506 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

Considering the fact that for an occurrence which  
took place on 09.05.2015, the complaint was filed on  
06.06.2017, which was referred to the police under sub-section  
(3) of Section 156 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for  
investigation pursuant to which the FIR was instituted on  
07.07.2017 and there is no plausible explanation for the



inordinate and unexplained delay caused in institution of the complaint, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- ( Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IIrd, Jamui in Laxmipur (Gidhaur) P. S. Case No.124 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
