5 13-09-2018 It is contended on behalf of the appellant that the parties have reached to out of court's settlement and, as such, a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") has already been jointly filed by the parties before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Purnea, bearing Matrimonial Case No.66/2018 on 23.04.2018.

As such, learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of such development having been taken place, he would seek leave to withdraw this appeal.
