The present writ petition has been filed for the following reliefs –

- (i) *For issuance of appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction(s) commanding the respondents for revocation of suspension as well as resumption of HP Gas (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) dealership (Domestic and Commercial) Agreement dated 29.04.2013, executed between the petitioner and HPCL after setting aside the letter dated 01.08.2017 issued by the Chief Regional Manager, HPCL, Patna (respondent*



no.2) whereby and whereunder the distributorship of the petitioner in the name and style of M/s Yuvraj Gramin Gas Vitrak has been suspended which is given for the sale of LPG known as HP Gas in cylinders only for household consumers and commercial consumers in the distribution area of Amnour, District Saran, Bihar.

(ii) To pass such other appropriate order or direction as it may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Sandip Singh submits that the grievance of the petitioner has now been redressed. In that view of the matter, the present writ petition need not be pressed.

3. The writ petition accordingly stands dismissed.
