This criminal writ application has been filed for
directing the respondent authorities to release original license
certificate bearing D.B.B.L. gun license no. 3709/16, Vaishali
in connection with Desari (Chandpura O.P.) P.S. Case No.
275/2016.

It appears from the statements made in paragraph-
5 of the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondent no.
5 that on the basis of recommendation of the Superintendent of
Police, Vaishali, the District Magistrate, Vaishali has cancelled
the Arms License No. 3709/2016 of the petitioner and the said
