The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case they are granted a liberty to file representation before the respondent no.2 and the respondent no.2 may be directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners shall file a consolidated representation before the respondent no.2 regarding their grievances raised in the writ petition within a



period of two weeks from today and the respondent no.2 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of four weeks thereafter, considering the decision taken by the cabinet dated 4.3.1014 and 21.3.2016 contained in Annexures-3 and 4 to the writ petition, which shall be filed by the petitioners along with their representation.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
