2 10-05-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection with
Noor Sarai P.S.Case No. 18 of 2018, registered for offences
punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504 of the
Indian Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner as per F.I.R. is that
the petitioner along with others committed assault and other co-
accused Fazahat Gope and Mithilesh Gope fired from their pistol,
causing fire arm injury to the informant as well as one Sarita
Kumari on her forehead.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that there is no any specific allegation has been attributed against



him .

Learned A.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances as discussed above, let the petitioner, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda, Bihar Sharif in connection with Noor Sarai P.S. Case No. 18 of 2018, subject to the condition that as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal procedure.

With following conditions:-

- i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police,



otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for
cancellation of his bail bond.
