2 19-06-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Raghunathpur P.S. Case No. - 181 of 2017 registered for the
offence punishable under sections 272, 273, 308 of the Indian
Penal Code and 30, 38, 41 of the Bihar Excise Prevention Act,
2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner has been implicated in the present case on the
basis of the confessional statement made by the co-accused. The
Motorcycle and the Pickup Van from where the recovery is said
to have been made does not belong to this petitioner. Similarly
situated co-accused person has been granted bail by this
Honorable Court vide order contained in Annexure-2.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Judge, Siwan in connection with Raghunathpur P.S. Case No.- 181 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
