State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Chakai P.S.
Case No. 22/2017, instituted for the offences punishable under
Sections 302, 34 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code read with
Sections 3/4 of the Prevention of Witch (Daain) Practices Act, 1999.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that
mere suspicion has been raised against these petitioners.

It is alleged in the written report that while the
informant was going to attend the call of nature, he saw the
petitioners coming from the river side, who changed their way after
seeing the informant. When the informant proceeded ahead, he



found the dead body of his father and mother poured with blood due to cut mark on their neck. In this manner, mere suspicion has been raised against these petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today, in connection with Chakai P.S. Case No. 22/2017, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-3rd, Jamui, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
