2. The present writ petition has been filed for the
following reliefs—

*“(A) A writ in the nature of CERTIORARI
or any other appropriate writ/s, order/s, direction/s for
quashing the tender Notice No. 1/2017-18 issued by the
Respondent no. 3 for 71 works for which last date for
depositing tender on 14.12.2017, as it is actuated by
malafide and large scale irregularities.*

*(B) A writ in the nature of MANDAMUS or
any other appropriate writ/s, order/s, direction/s for*



commanding and directing the Respondent Authorities to republish the tender in accordance with relevant guidelines and directions.

(C) To any other relief/s to which the petitioner is found entitled.”
