Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this application is allowed. Order passed on 17.10.2017 in L.P.A. No. 1192 of 2017 is further modified to the extent that apart from release of the food grains on conditions indicated in the order passed on 17.10.2017, the godown of the petitioner shall also be unsealed and possession given to the petitioner on furnishing two sureties to the satisfaction of the competent authority and undertaking not to alienate the property or create third party interest in the godown during the pendency of the



matter before the competent authority.
