After some arguments, the learned counsel for the

within a period of two weeks from today and in case, the petitioner
surrenders within a period of two weeks, the concerned Court shall

days in filing the F.I.R. as also the fact that the petitioner is not the



person who has assaulted the son of the informant who is the deceased in the present case.
