ORAL ORDER

2 21-02-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the concerned authority regarding non-grant of benefit of A.C.P. and M.A.C.P. and the concerned authority be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievance before the respondent no. 3 and the respondent no. 3 is directed to dispose of the said representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

In case any consequential benefit is found payable, the same shall be paid within a period of four weeks from the date of passing of the said order.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
