counsel for the respondents.

The present application has been filed for modification
of order dated 04.07.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 16954 of 2010
by which the writ petition was disposed of with liberty to the
petitioner to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority,



within a period of thirty days from the date of order i.e., 04.07.2017.
