Heard Mr. Mukesh Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Rakesh Srivastava, learned AC to GP-15.

The present Writ application has been filed for a direction to the respondent authorities to take appropriate action against respondent no. 7, who forcibly encroached upon the land appertaining to Khata No. 626, Plot Nos. 1802, 1803, 1804, 1805 and 1806 situated in village – Chittuaria, P.S. – Mansahi, District – Katihar, as the said land was settled to the petitioners by virtue



of being declared surplus in Land Ceiling Case No. 14 of 2009-10.

Considering the nature of prayer, learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to withdraw this application to seek alternative remedy before appropriate forum, particularly, before the authority under Bihar Land Dispute Resolution Act.

Accordingly, this Writ application is disposed of.
