ORAL ORDER

2 19-11-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners
and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 279, 307, 323, 324, 341, 354, 379 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation of commission of assault is general and omnibus against the named accused person including 12 petitioners.

Submission is that Doctor has found simple



injury on the person of the injured.

Considering the facts of this case aforesaid especially general nature of allegation, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Patori (Mohanpur O.P.) P.S.Case No. 143 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
