4 11-01-2019 It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that due to inadvertence mention of petitioner no.5 Yugal Kishore Singh in order dated 20.12.2018 as beneficiary of the said order is missing in the order. Though the prayer made on behalf of petitioner no.5 Yugal Kishore Singh was allowed, the same has escaped mention in the order dated 20.12.2018 due to typographical error.

Aforesaid fact is not disputed by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the opposite party.
