2 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Brahmpur (Krishna Brahm) P.S. Case No. 247 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 363/366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are father and mother of the boy with whom the victim girl had fled away. He further submits that they are major and with their own sweet will they are living together.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are father and mother and they have no criminal antecedent, the Court is



inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on the condition that the Court below will ascertain whether the girl was major on the date of occurrence and if it is found that the girl was major on the date of occurrence the Court below released the petitioners on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of Learned C.J.M., Buxar in connection with Brahmpur, P.S. Case No. 247 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
