ORAL ORDER

2 28-11-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The present application has been filed for modification of the order dated 25.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64784 of 2018, by which the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail in connection with Khagaria (Gangaur) P.S. Case No. 176 of 2018, pending in the court of learned C.J.M., Khagaria and the petitioners were directed to surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks and furnish bail bond.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that due to



some unavoidable reasons the petitioners could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is prayed on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioners that address of the petitioners may be corrected in the order dated 25.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64784 of 2018 as ‘ village- Olapur, Gangaur, P.S. Gangaur’ in place of ‘resident of Pratappur Gangaur, P.S. Gogri’. It is further submitted that further time may be extended so that the petitioners could surrender in the court below and furnish bail bond.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioners and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the address of the petitioners in the order dated 25.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64784 of 2018 be read as ‘Village-Olapur, Gangaur, P.S.Gangaur’ in place of ‘resident of Pratappur Gangaur, P.S. Gogri’ and the period of surrender of the petitioners in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 25.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 64784 of 2018, is modified to the extent as indicated above.
