ORAL ORDER

8 12-10-2018 The petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2018 in connection with Jakkanpur P.S. Case No. 129 of 2018 (Arising out of Spl. Case No. 2472 of 2018), registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 324, 307, 427, 504, 353 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 37(c) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is that in the drunken condition, he along with other accused persons assaulted the police party.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the present case has been lodged due to high handedness of the police. Further submission is that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he has been in custody since 17.03.2018 and



charge-sheet has already been submitted.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna, in connection with Jakkanpur P.S. Case No. 129 of 2018 (Arising out of Spl. Case No. 2472 of 2018), with following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing



any genuine reasons, the prosecution is
free to move for cancellation of his bail.
