4 06-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State as well as the Board.

In the present writ petition, the petitioner is challenging the order vide Memo No. 2968 dated 29.06.2017 by which the Bihar State Housing Board, Patna has refused to extend the service of the petitioner further.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as it is a stigmatic order, it will cause prejudice the future of the petitioner. The respondents were proposing to initiate a proceeding against the petitioner, but ultimately, an innocuous order has been passed refusing to extend the service of the



petitioner further.

In such view of the matter, the aforesaid order will not
cause any prejudice to the petitioner in future.
