Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for bail vide order dated 20.06.2018 passed by the learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge I/C., Saharsa, in connection with Salkhua Police Station Case No.245 of 2016, registered under Sections 147/148/149/341/342/323/367/511 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 27 of the Arms Act and Section 3(i)(r) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

A civil suit is going on between the parties. In the aforesaid background allegation of commission of abuse and assault



and attempt to abduct the informant.

Considering the background and nature of allegation, let the appellant, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with condition that the appellant shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and appeal is allowed.
