Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in Kasim Bazar P.S. Case
No. 165 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections-302, 120(B)
& other minor Sections of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms
Act.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is
no allegation of any specific overt act against the petitioner. He has
clean antecedent.

The allegation has been made against the petitioner in the
last paragraph that he had come to the house of the informant with other
and gave information to the informant that he was sent by Pawan
Mandal and said Pawan Mandal had said to compromise the case and
when he refused, then he gave threat.

In such circumstances, prayer for anticipatory bail is



allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner named above in the event of his arrest or surrender in the court below within six weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with in Kasim Bazar P.S. Case No. 165 of 2017 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger subject to condition as laid down u/S 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason, will liable to cancel bail bond of the petitioner and (3) if petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
