Heard counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the Union of India. Perused the impugned order dated 31.05.2017 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench, Patna in O.A. No. 605 of 2015.

Merely because the litigant gets wiser after every round of litigation and keeps improving the case by all kinds of contrived evidence or documents, the Court cannot be taken in by such clever



ploy.

The infirmities in the facts have been noticed by the learned Member of the Tribunal in the impugned order dated 31.05.2017. In our opinion these are good grounds for not extending any kind of relief or benefit to the petitioner because his sole effort is to obtain employment under the Union of India by hook or by crook.

Writ has no merit. It is dismissed.
