3 08-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned APP
for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party No.2.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 323, 504, 498A, 307, 406, 467, 468 of
the Indian Penal Code and $\frac{3}{4}$ of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of committing
torture and assault upon the victim due to non-fulfilment of
demand of dowry.

Both the parties are present in Court. They have
settled the dispute between them and mutually consented for
residing together.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of the



parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in connection with Complaint case No.825 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
