3 08-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP
for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Madhepura P.S. case
no. 367/2016 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 323,
341, 365, 307, 379 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged in the written report that these petitioners
along with 15-20 unknown boys surrounded the vehicle of the
informant and assaulted him and thereafter they took him away
in the house of Vishal Kumar Bablu and also kept the



informant in a forest situated by the side of a river by tying with bamboo clump.

The injury report of the injured is enclosed as Annexure-2 to the bail petition wherein the doctor has found only bruise and swelling over the person of the injured.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with Madhepura P.S. case no. 367/2016, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM Madhepura, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C. with further conditions:(1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of



the petitioners.
