3 25-06-2018 The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 680 of 2017, registered

for offences punishable under Sections 304(B), 201 and 34 of the

Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegation against the petitioners is of demand of dowry
and causing the death of the deceased.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that
petitioner no. 1 is father in law of the deceased and petitioner nos.
2 and 3 are the brothers in law of the deceased and they have no
role to play in the death of the deceased and no specific allegation
has been attributed to them rather the true fact is that the deceased
was coming along with her husband and in the way, she felt severe



abdominal pain, for which she was taken to hospital and died and a U.D. case has also been lodged by the husband of the deceased.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 680 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, as well as subject to the following conditions, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation and make themselves available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on their part to appear



before the police on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail bonds.
