APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 341, 323, 452, 386, 307, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case, in short, is that while the informant was at his door, the accused persons, variously armed, reached and demanded some rangdari and on refusal, they assaulted the informant due to which he sustained injury.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the



present case. The matter has already been compromised between the parties vide Annexure-2 to the present application.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda, Bihar Sharif in connection with Rahui (Bhaganbigha) P.S. Case No. 233/18, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
