Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Barachatti Police Station Case No. 265 of 2018,
disclosing offences under Sections 30(a), 38 and 47 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is innocent and
has not committed any offence. In fact, nothing has been
recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
Moreover, the petitioner is not involved in dealing with illegal
liquor. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of
anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya, in connection with Barachatti Police Station Case No. 265 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
