APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 272, 273, 308 of the Indian Penal Code and 30(a), 38 and 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 2 liters wine is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has transpired as the abandoned shop in question belongs to the petitioner. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the



implication of the petitioner in this case. It is alleged that 2 liters wine is recovered from the abandoned shop in question. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge -cum- Special Judge, Excise, Siwan in connection with G.B. P.S. Case No. 261 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
