ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420,406 of the Indian Penal Code .

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was running a none government organization and got deposited donation and other fee in his account from his members.

Submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the informant has no concerned with the aforesaid organization and moreover, not a single officials and members of the said organization has made any complaint against the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as



well as submissions of the parties, this anticipatory bail petition is allowed and it is ordered that petitioner, in the event of his arrest/ surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the court concerned, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate1st, Bagaha, West Champaran, Bettiah in Bagaha (Pathkhouli) P.S. Case No. 449 of 2018 subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
